

**NOTICE OF A GENERAL ELECTION TO ALL
QUALIFIED VOTERS WITHIN THE CITY BRENHAM, TEXAS**

1. A General Election will be held on Saturday, May 4, 2019 for the purpose of electing a Mayor, one (1) Councilmember for Place 2, Ward 2, and one (1) Councilmember for Place 4, Ward 4. Each for four (4) year terms.

2. The polling locations for each Ward on Election Day are as follows:

4. Early voting by personal appearance and by mail shall be during the period of April 22, 2019 through April 30, 2019. The Early Voting Clerk for said election shall be the City Secretary. She shall appoint the Washington County Chief Deputy Elections Clerk as Deputy Early Voting Clerk. The main early voting polling place by personal appearance shall be at the Washington County Annex Building, 100 S. Park Street, Brenham, Texas. Early voting by personal appearance for the General Election shall be held on the following dates and times:
