Washington County officials announced Friday that the first COVID-19 positive patient has died. A male, 80-89 years old with multiple underlying medical conditions passed away early Friday morning. "It's with a heavy heart that we have to announce that Washington County has lost one of our residents to COVID-19," said Judge John Durrenberger, Washington County Judge. He added, "The numbers we report every day are not statistics. These are our fellow community members who are fighting a tough battle."
