Brenham | Washington County Economic Development Receives Excellence in Economic Development Award from the International Economic Development Council

Brenham | Washington County Economic Development won a Gold Rank for its Economic Development Website, a project in the category of General Purpose Website of the International Economic Development Council (IEDC). The honor was presented today at an awards ceremony during the IEDC Annual Conference, which is currently underway.

IEDC's Excellence in Economic Development Awards recognize the world's best economic development programs and partnerships, marketing materials, and the year's most influential leaders. 35 award categories honor organizations and individuals for their efforts in creating positive change in urban, suburban, and rural communities. Awards are judged by a diverse panel of economic and community developers from around the world, following a nomination process held earlier this year. Awards in each category are Gold, Silver, and Bronze. IEDC received over 500 submissions from 4 countries.

Cates continued, "The critical importance of the secondary goal became apparent during the COVID-19 pandemic as our community successfully utilized our website for a variety of information. One of the key components to ensure that we can restore the vitality of our economy is to provide accurate and up-to-date information. The design and ease of use of our website made that possible."

"The winners of IEDC's Excellence in Economic Development awards represent the very best of economic development and exemplify the ingenuity, integrity, and leadership that our profession strives for each and every day", said 2020 IEDC Board Chair and One Columbus CEO Kenny McDonald.
